MOW – Once per week (as temperatures rise you should raise your mowing height)

PLANT – From seed

Globe Amaranth

Dig and divide crowded spring blooming bulbs every 3 to 4 years

WATER – Deep water – Soak – Don't

Dead And Diseased Wood

Perennials as soon as finished blooming

Petunias for new blooms later on

Faded flowers before they set seed

Salvia Farinacea

FERTILIZE

Second major fertilization of Lawns

All Planting Areas

Fertilize Mums (pinch out buds)

Roses every 4 to 6 weeks

WATCH FOR

Powdery Mildew on Carpe Myrtles,

Roses and Photinia

Chinch Bug on Grasses especially St.

Augustine

Red Spiders on everything – check the
underside of foliage

Black spot on Roses

Second generation of all insects
